Drywall Taping Knife (hardware store) - various sizes (see pict)
Palette knifes in assorted shapes - Big and small
Palette (large)
Mineral spirits with a Container (Gamblin Gamsol is best)
Brushes - Bristle brushes are best in various sizes ( $\# 1,4,6,8,10$ )
Mop brushes or cheap hardware store wood handle bristle brushes (1"-2")
Paper towels (Viva recommended, NO PATTERN)
Trash Bag (grocery size)
